Our children in STEM last week have been working hard engaged in World Space Week 2022 with various activities and The Great Big Green Week activities at the end of September.

Class Activities

The last couple of week sessions, all our children in STEM have been working really hard designing some amazing spaceship and rocket creations. They also 3D printed the ISS and lots of learning on



'Busy Things' and naming planets. Children enjoyed using the 3D pen to create around spaceships and satellite templates and drawings of Planets including Hour of Code Space Quest activities following instructions and learning how to code commands to astronauts to complete challenges. They worked on gravity simulators to explore how space junk orbits the Earth.

During the Great Big Green Week, the children enjoyed 3D printing their own Amazon rainforest designs, Ecosystems and using the 3D pen with all things green. They explored and worked hard using 'Tree World' to simulate a planet climate change and look after its wildlife and the environment. Children have been investigating biodegradable PLA plastic under the microscope and exploring green recyclable things.
