
Winter, ice, snow, frozen, North Pole, Arctic animals and Scratch coding.

Class Activities



They have also started writing their own winter stories on 'Just2easy Write' about living on an iceberg at the North Pole with animals. During their winter experiments, they have been visually experimenting with ice, water, snow, and salt.
